

ADDITIONAL INSURED - LESSOR OF EQUIPMENT ENDORSEMENT (General Liability)

This endorsement modifies insurance provided under the:

GENERAL LIABILITY COVERAGE PART

In consideration of the additional premium, solely with respect to the coverage afforded by this endorsement, the policy is amended as follows:

Information required to complete this Schedule, if not shown above, will be shown in the Declarations.

The definition of **Insured**, set forth in Section II, Coverage Part Definitions, is amended to add the following:

Any person or entity shown in the Schedule above from whom a **named insured** leases equipment is an additional **insured**, subject to all other terms and conditions of the policy, provided:

- 1. the insurance afforded such additional **insured** applies only for the vicarious liability imposed upon such additional **insured** due to the ownership, maintenance or use of the leased equipment, and not for any liability arising out of the additional **insured's** own actual or alleged acts, errors or omissions; and
- 2. the occurrence giving rise to such bodily injury, property damage or the offense causing the personal and advertising injury takes place prior to the expiration of such lease.

However, if coverage for the additional **insured** is required by written contract or agreement, subject always to the terms and conditions of this policy, including the Limit of Liability, the coverage provided to such additional **insured**:

- 1. will not be broader than required by such contract or agreement; or
- 2. will not be at a higher limit of insurance than required by such contract or agreement; and
- 3. will apply solely to the extent permissible by law.

All other terms and conditions of the Policy remain unchanged.

This endorsement, which forms a part of and is for attachment to the Policy issued by the designated Insurers, takes effect on the effective date of said Policy at the hour stated in said Policy, unless another effective date is shown below, and expires concurrently with said Policy.
